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STURGEON RIVER MANAGEMENT AREA

The Sturgeon River Management Area is open for unguided users from November 12 to August 15 each year. During other dates visitors must be accompanied by a guide.

KARLUK RIVER DESIGNATED CAMPING AREAS

Camping is prohibited in certain areas with sensitive habitats along the Karluk River. The areas listed below are open to overnight camping. Users may spend up to one week in each designated area. Group size is limited to 6 people.

Area 1: Upper Karluk

Lands within 1/4 mile of the east side of Karluk River, bounded by N 57° 28' 5" x W 154° 9' 51" downriver to N 57° 31' 32" x W 154° 9' 46"

Area 2: Little Bend

Lands within 1/4 mile of the west side of Karluk River, bounded by N 57° 33' 33" x W 154° 11' 41" downriver to N 57° 33' 51" x W 154° 11' 52"

Area 3: Shasta Creek

Lands within 1/4 mile of the south side of Karluk River, bounded by N 57° 33' 17" x W 154° 16' 54" downriver to N 57° 33' 15" x W 154° 17' 33"

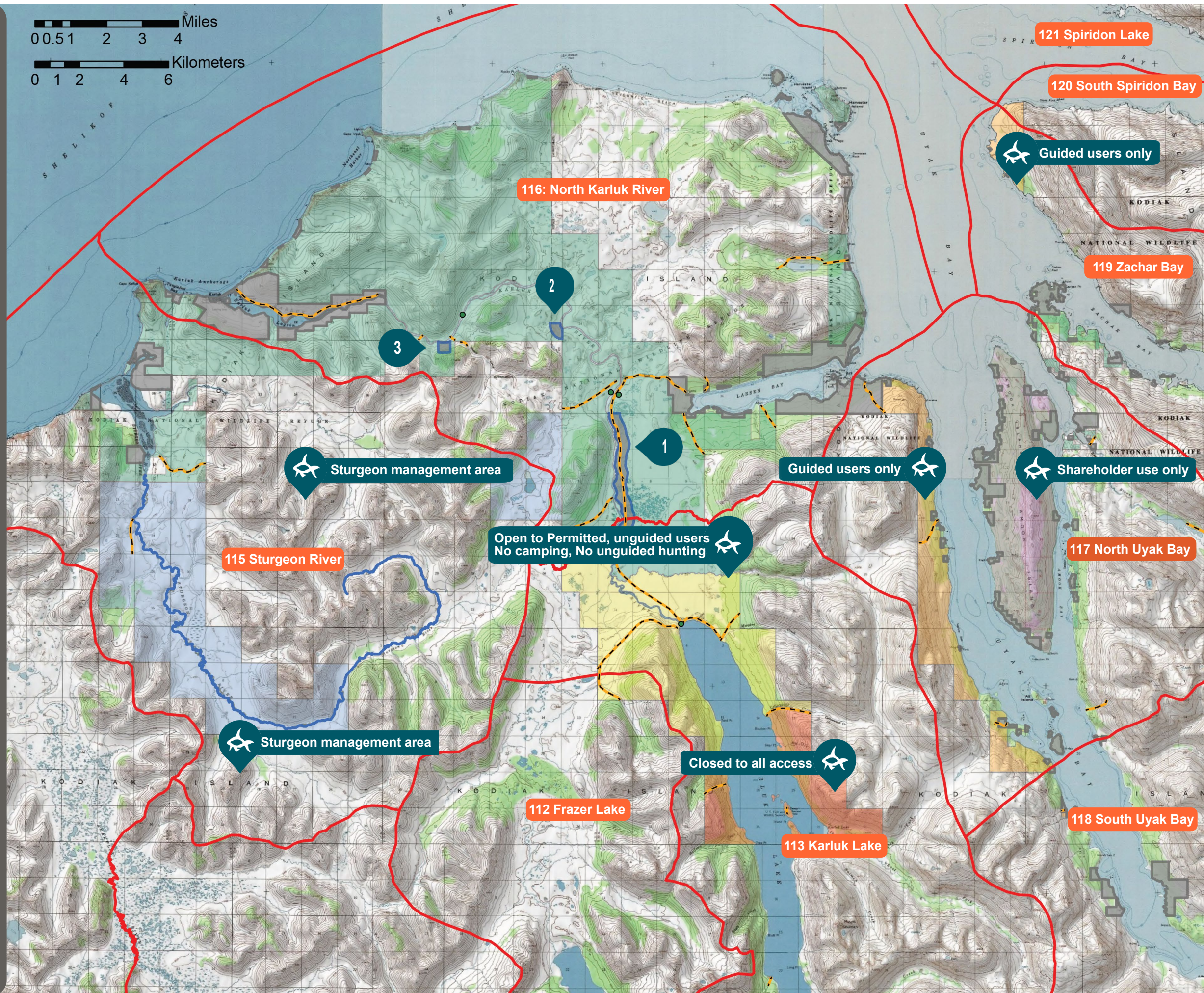
